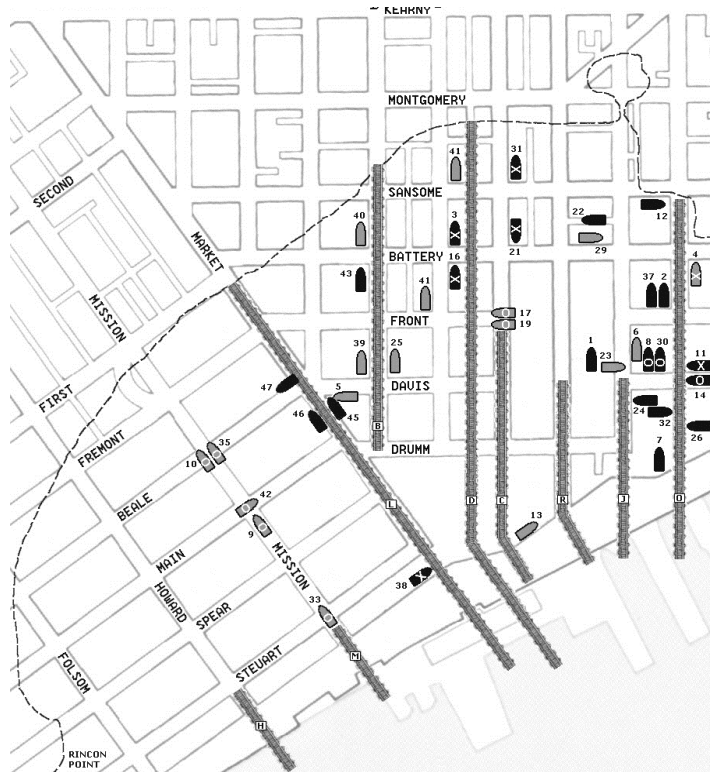


There are ships buried under Market Street

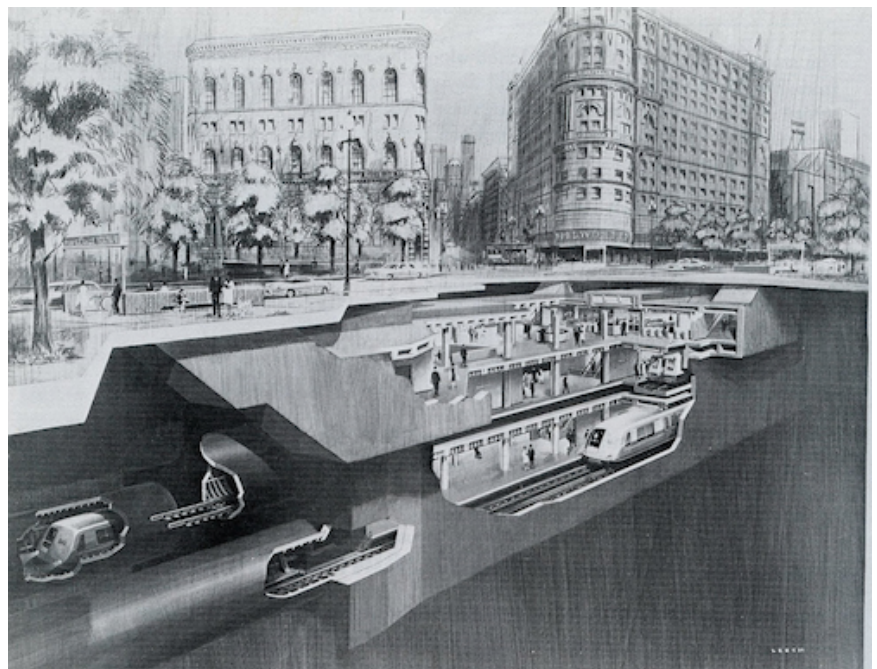
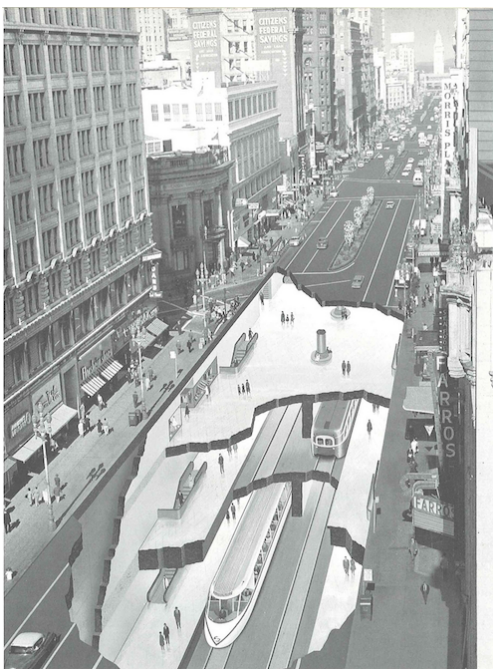
